Audits. 13 (a) General rule.--14 (1) The Office of Auditor General shall have the power 15 and its duty shall be to audit the accounts and records of 16 every volunteer firefighters' relief association receiving 17 money under Chapter 7 of the act of December 18, 1984 18 (P.L.1005, No.205), known as the Municipal Pension Plan 19 Funding Standard and Recovery Act, as far as may be necessary 20 to satisfy the Auditor General that the money received was or 21 is being expended for no purpose other than that authorized 22 by this subchapter. Copies of all audits shall be furnished 23 to the Governor. 24 (2) The commissioner shall establish and publish 25 annually, in consultation with the Auditor General, eligible 26 uses of the money in accordance with this subchapter. 27 (3) Notwithstanding paragraph (1), the commissioner shall maintain authority relating to the eligible uses of 28 29 money received. 30 Findings.--If the Auditor General finds that [any] money (b) 20150HB1717PN2584 - 3 -

1 received by a volunteer firefighters' relief association has been expended for a purpose other than one authorized by this 2 subchapter, the Auditor General shall immediately notify the 3 Governor and the commissioner and shall decline to approve 4 further requisitions calling for payment to the volunteer 5 firefighters' relief association until the improperly expended 6 amount has been reimbursed to the relief association fund. 7 Section 5. This act shall take effect in 60 days. 8
