A JOINT RESOLUTION

1 2 3	Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, further providing for method of elections and secrecy in voting.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby resolves as follows:
6	Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of
7	Pennsylvania is proposed in accordance with Article XI:
8	That section 4 of Article VII be amended to read:
9	§ 4. Method of elections; secrecy in voting.
10	[All] Except as permitted by absentee ballot under section 14
11	of this article, all elections by the citizens shall be by
12	ballot [or by such other method as may be prescribed by law:]
13	cast in person by electors at their polling place, including
14	early in-person voting, as prescribed by law: Provided, That
15	secrecy in voting be preserved.
16	Section 2. (a) Upon the first passage by the General
17	Assembly of this proposed constitutional amendment, the

18 Secretary of the Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to

1 comply with the advertising requirements of section 1 of Article
2 XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and shall transmit the
3 required advertisements to two newspapers in every county in
4 which such newspapers are published in sufficient time after
5 passage of this proposed constitutional amendment.

6 Upon the second passage by the General Assembly of this (b) 7 proposed constitutional amendment, the Secretary of the 8 Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to comply with the 9 advertising requirements of section 1 of Article XI of the 10 Constitution of Pennsylvania and shall transmit the required 11 advertisements to two newspapers in every county in which such 12 newspapers are published in sufficient time after passage of 13 this proposed constitutional amendment. The Secretary of the 14 Commonwealth shall submit this proposed constitutional amendment 15 to the qualified electors of this Commonwealth at the first 16 primary, general or municipal election which meets the 17 requirements of and is in conformance with section 1 of Article XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and which occurs at least 18 19 three months after the proposed constitutional amendment is 20 passed by the General Assembly.
