5	Section 1. Section 3736 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
6	Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
7	§ 3736. Reckless driving.
8	(a) General ruleAny person who drives any vehicle in
9	willful or wanton disregard for the safety of persons or
10	property is guilty of reckless driving.
11	(a.1) Excess speedingAny person who drives any vehicle at
12	<u>a speed of 100 miles per hour or more or in excess of the</u>
13	maximum speed limit by 45 miles per hour or more is guilty under
14	subsection (a).
15	(b) PenaltyAny person who violates this section commits a
16	summary offense and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay
17	a fine of \$200.
18	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
