AN ACT

- Amending Titles 8 (Boroughs and Incorporated Towns) and 11
 (Cities) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in
 associations and organizations relating to boroughs, further
 providing for authorization and expenses; and, in city
 officers and employees relating to third class cities,
 further providing for Pennsylvania Municipal League and othe
- further providing for Pennsylvania Municipal League and other municipal affairs organizations.
- 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 9 hereby enacts as follows:
- 10 Section 1. Section 701.1 of Title 8 of the Pennsylvania
- 11 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 12 § 701.1. Authorization and expenses.
- 13 (a) Delegates. -- Council may, by motion, designate one or
- 14 more delegates from the elected or appointed officers or newly
- 15 <u>elected officers prior to officially taking office</u> of the
- 16 borough to attend the annual meeting of the State Association of
- 17 Boroughs, which shall be held in this Commonwealth in accordance
- 18 with the procedure adopted by the State Association of Boroughs.
- 19 (b) Nondelegates.--Council may, by motion, designate one or

- 1 more elected or appointed officers or newly elected officers
- 2 prior to officially taking office or employees of the borough to
- 3 attend the annual meeting of the State Association of Boroughs
- 4 as nondelegates or to attend a conference, educational training
- 5 or committee meeting of the State Association of Boroughs.
- 6 (c) Expenses. -- The following shall apply:
- 7 (1) In addition to any compensation allowed under
 8 section 701.2 (relating to compensation), council may, for
 9 each delegate, elected or appointed officer or newly elected
 10 officers prior to officially taking office or employee under
 11 subsection (a) or (b), pay the following expenses upon
- 12 receipt of an itemized account of expenses:
- 13 (i) The registration fee.
- (ii) Mileage for use of a personal vehicle or
 reimbursement of actual transportation expenses going to
 and returning from the annual meeting, conference,
 educational training or committee meeting of the State
 Association of Boroughs.
- 19 (iii) Any actual expenses that the council may have 20 agreed to pay.
- 21 (2) Notwithstanding this subsection, at least one member 22 of council shall be allowed the following expenses:
- 23 (i) The registration fee.
- 24 (ii) Lodging, meals and mileage for use of a
 25 personal vehicle or reimbursement of actual
 26 transportation expenses going to and returning from the
 27 meeting.
- 28 (iii) Any actual expenses that the council may have 29 agreed to pay.

4	(a) UnificationA city may:

6	(2) form and organize a municipal league of cities and
7	municipalities; and
8	(3) hold annual conventions, educational training and
9	meetings for the study and consideration of municipal affairs
10	of concern [that pertain] to the cities and municipalities
11	comprising the league.
12	(b) Delegates. A city that is a member of the league may do
13	the following:
14	(1) Send delegates to the [league.] league's annual
15	conference, educational training and meetings. Newly elected
16	or appointed officials prior to officially taking office may
17	attend the league's annual conference, educational training
18	and meetings.
19	(2) Pay the necessary expenses, including:
20	(i) Incidental expenses [to attend the annual-
21	convention] of those attending the league's annual
22	conference, educational training and meetings.
23	(ii) Dues to the league.
24	(iii) Appropriate money to join and participate in
25	any of the various business and training programs of the
26	league designed to address municipal needs in a cost
27	efficient manner.
28	(3) Provide a fund for the necessary costs and expenses
29	of participation in the league [and league conventions].
30	(c) Accounting. Each [delegate] official shall submit to

- 1 the city controller for approval an itemized account of the
- 2 delegate's expenses to be paid under the authority of this-
- 3 section.
- 4 (2) FORM AND ORGANIZE A <u>MUNICIPAL</u> LEAGUE [OF CITIES AND <--
- 5 MUNICIPALITIES]; AND
- 6 (3) HOLD [ANNUAL CONVENTIONS] CONFERENCES, EDUCATIONAL
- 7 TRAININGS AND MEETINGS FOR THE STUDY AND CONSIDERATION OF
- 8 MUNICIPAL AFFAIRS [OF CONCERN THAT PERTAIN TO THE CITIES AND
- 9 MUNICIPALITIES COMPRISING THE LEAGUE].
- 10 (B) [DELEGATES] OFFICIALS AND EXPENSES. -- A CITY [THAT IS A
- 11 MEMBER OF THE LEAGUE] MAY [DO THE FOLLOWING]:
- 12 (1) SEND [DELEGATES TO THE LEAGUE.] OFFICIALS TO THE
- 13 LEAGUE'S CONFERENCES, EDUCATIONAL TRAININGS AND MEETINGS.
- 14 NEWLY ELECTED OR APPOINTED OFFICIALS PRIOR TO OFFICIALLY
- 15 TAKING OFFICE MAY ATTEND THE LEAGUE'S CONFERENCES,
- 16 EDUCATIONAL TRAININGS AND MEETINGS.
- 17 (2) PAY THE NECESSARY EXPENSES[, INCLUDING:
- 18 (I) INCIDENTAL EXPENSES TO ATTEND THE ANNUAL
- 19 CONVENTION.
- 20 (II) DUES TO THE LEAGUE.] OF THOSE ATTENDING THE
- 21 LEAGUE'S CONFERENCES, EDUCATIONAL TRAININGS AND MEETINGS,
- 22 <u>INCLUDING INCIDENTAL EXPENSES.</u>
- 23 (3) APPROPRIATE MONEY FOR DUES TO THE LEAGUE.
- 24 [(III)] (4) APPROPRIATE MONEY TO JOIN AND
- 25 PARTICIPATE IN ANY OF THE VARIOUS BUSINESS AND TRAINING
- 26 PROGRAMS OF THE LEAGUE DESIGNED TO ADDRESS MUNICIPAL
- 27 NEEDS IN A COST-EFFICIENT MANNER.
- 28 [(3)] (5) PROVIDE A FUND FOR THE NECESSARY COSTS AND
- 29 EXPENSES OF <u>PARTICIPATION IN</u> THE LEAGUE [AND LEAGUE
- 30 CONVENTIONS].

- 1 (C) ACCOUNTING.--EACH [DELEGATE] OFFICIAL SHALL SUBMIT TO
- 2 THE CITY CONTROLLER FOR APPROVAL AN ITEMIZED ACCOUNT OF THE
- 3 [DELEGATE'S] OFFICIAL'S EXPENSES TO BE PAID UNDER THE AUTHORITY
- 4 OF THIS SECTION.
