## AN ACT

1 2 3	Requiring postsecondary institutions to establish and maintain sexual harassment and sexual violence online reporting systems; and prescribing a penalty.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Short title.
7	This act shall be known and may be cited as the Postsecondary
8	Institution Online Reporting System Act.
9	Section 2. Definitions.
10	The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
11	have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
12	context clearly indicates otherwise:
13	"Online reporting system." A system established under this
14	act.
15	"Postsecondary institution." Any of the following:
16	(1) A community college as defined under section 1901-A
17	of the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the

1 Public School Code of 1949.

2 (2) A university under the jurisdiction of the State3 System of Higher Education.

4 (3) A university located in this Commonwealth that5 receives a nonpreferred appropriation.

6 (4) A private postsecondary institution.
7 "Secretary." The Secretary of the Budget of the

8 Commonwealth.

9 Section 3. Online reporting system.

10 (a) Establishment.--

11 (1) A postsecondary institution shall establish and 12 maintain an online reporting system to receive complaints of 13 sexual harassment and sexual violence from students and 14 employees.

15 (2) A postsecondary institution shall investigate a 16 complaint received by the online reporting system. The 17 investigation shall be conducted in accordance with the 18 process established in the postsecondary institution's sexual 19 harassment and sexual violence policy.

(3) A postsecondary institution may not fail or refuse
to investigate a complaint solely for the reason that the
complaint was submitted anonymously.

(b) Anonymous reports.--An online reporting system shall
permit anonymous complaints to be reported and the complaints
shall be investigated in accordance with subsection (a).

26 (c) Required information.--A postsecondary institution shall 27 provide a student and employee who reports a complaint under 28 this section with the following:

29 (1) Information regarding who will receive and have30 access to the complaint.

(2) How information gathered through the online
 reporting system will be used.

3 (3) Contact information for on-campus and off-campus
4 organizations serving victims of sexual harassment and sexual
5 violence.

6 (d) Statement.--The online reporting system shall7 prominently display the following statement:

8 It is important to note that while the (name of the 9 postsecondary institution) will evaluate all reports of 10 sexual assault and sexual harassment, the (name of the postsecondary institution's) ability to investigate and 11 12 respond to allegations and provide feedback to an 13 individual reporting a complaint may be limited depending 14 on the information provided in the complaint. Individuals 15 are encouraged to review the (name of the postsecondary institution's) policy for investigating reports of sexual 16 17 violence for more information about procedures and 18 resources.

(e) Access to data.--A postsecondary institution shall limit
access to the data collected, created or maintained under
subsection (a) to only the data as follows:

(1) Only individuals with explicit authorization from
the postsecondary institution may enter, update, access,
share or disseminate electronic data related to an incident
of sexual harassment or sexual violence collected, created or
maintained under this section.

(2) The ability of an authorized individual to enter,
update, access, share or disseminate data shall be limited
through the use of role-based access that corresponds to the
official duties or training level of the individual and the

institutional authorization that grants access for that
 purpose.

3 (3) Actions in which the data relates to an incident of 4 sexual harassment or sexual violence are entered, updated, 5 accessed, shared or disseminated outside of the postsecondary 6 institution shall be recorded in a data audit trail.

7 (4) The postsecondary institution shall immediately and
8 permanently revoke the authorization of an individual
9 determined to have willfully entered, updated, accessed,
10 shared or disseminated data in violation of this section.
11 Section 4. Penalty.

12 (a) Withholding of appropriations.--The Secretary of the 13 Budget shall withhold money appropriated to or on behalf of a 14 postsecondary institution that fails to establish and maintain 15 an online reporting system as required under this act.

(b) Lapsing.--Money withheld by the secretary under this section shall lapse to the General Fund at the end of the fiscal year for which they are appropriated, unless the postsecondary institution demonstrates to the satisfaction of the secondary that the postsecondary institution has complied with the requirements of this act.

22 Section 5. Effective date.

23 This act shall take effect in one year.
