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19 The following words and phrases when used in this chapter

- 1 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 2 <u>context clearly indicates otherwise:</u>
- 3 "Authority." The Pennsylvania Minority Business Development
- 4 Authority established under the act of July 22, 1974 (P.L.598,
- 5 No.206), known as the Pennsylvania Minority Business Development
- 6 Authority Act.
- 7 "Disadvantaged business." A business that is owned or
- 8 controlled by a majority of persons, not limited to members of
- 9 minority groups, who are subject to racial or ethnic prejudice
- 10 or cultural bias.
- 11 "Diverse business." A disadvantaged business, minority-owned
- 12 or women-owned business or service-disabled veteran-owned or
- 13 <u>veteran-owned small business that has been certified by a third-</u>
- 14 party certifying organization.
- 15 <u>"Minority-owned business." A business owned and controlled</u>
- 16 by a majority of individuals who are African Americans, Hispanic
- 17 Americans, Native Americans, Asian Americans, Alaskans or
- 18 Pacific Islanders.
- 19 "Redevelopment Assistance Capital Program." A Commonwealth
- 20 grant program administered by the Office of the Budget for the
- 21 acquisition and construction of regional economic, cultural,
- 22 civic, recreational and historical improvement projects.
- 23 "Service-disabled veteran-owned small business." As defined
- 24 in 51 Pa.C.S. § 9601 (relating to definitions).
- 25 "Third-party certifying organization." An organization that
- 26 certifies a small business, minority-owned business, women-owned
- 27 <u>business or veteran-owned small business as a diverse business.</u>
- 28 The term includes:
- 29 <u>(1) The National Minority Supplier Development Council.</u>
- 30 (2) The Women's Business Development Enterprise National

- 1 Council.
- 2 (3) The Small Business Administration.
- 3 (4) The Department of Veterans Affairs.
- 4 (5) The Pennsylvania Unified Certification Program.
- 5 <u>"Veteran-owned small business."</u> As defined in 51 Pa.C.S. §
- 6 9601 (relating to definitions).
- 7 <u>"Women-owned business."</u> A business owned and controlled by a
- 8 <u>majority of individuals who are women.</u>
- 9 <u>§ 4203. Diverse business participation.</u>
- 10 (a) Duties.--In administering grants under the Redevelopment
- 11 Assistance Capital Program, the Office of the Budget shall:
- 12 (1) Seek the maximum participation by diverse
- businesses, including ensuring that the commitment to
- 14 participation by diverse businesses is clearly understood and
- 15 <u>appropriately implemented and enforced.</u>
- 16 (2) Designate a responsible official to supervise the
- 17 program's objectives relating to diverse businesses.
- 18 (3) Revoke agreements under the program if the grantees
- 19 fail to comply with this section or the policies of the
- 20 <u>Commonwealth relating to diverse businesses.</u>
- 21 (4) Ensure that agreements entered into with grantees
- 22 under the program include provisions prohibiting
- 23 <u>discrimination in accordance with the laws of this</u>
- 24 Commonwealth.
- 25 (b) Additional duties. -- The Office of the Budget, with the
- 26 assistance of a diverse business enterprise supportive services
- 27 center, shall have the following duties:
- 28 (1) Conduct the necessary and appropriate outreach,
- 29 <u>including using the database available on the publicly</u>
- 30 accessible Internet website of the Department of General

- 1 Services and the Federal Government's system of award
- 2 <u>management database, for purposes of identifying diverse</u>
- 3 businesses who qualify for the program.
- 4 (2) By October 1, 2018, and each October 1 thereafter,
- 5 <u>submit a report to the authority summarizing the</u>
- 6 participation level of diverse businesses under the program.
- 7 The report shall include the following:
- 8 <u>(i) The percentage of participation by diverse</u>
- 9 <u>businesses in the program.</u>
- 10 (ii) The total value of all agreements executed
- 11 <u>under the program which include participation by diverse</u>
- businesses in the prior year.
- 13 <u>(iii) The number of grantees penalized for violating</u>
- this section.
- 15 <u>(c) Review.--The authority shall review the report under</u>
- 16 <u>subsection</u> (b) (2) to assess the effectiveness of administering
- 17 this section and make any recommendations for changes deemed
- 18 necessary to maximize the participation of diverse businesses in
- 19 the program to the Office of the Budget.
- 20 (d) Construction. -- Nothing in this section shall be
- 21 construed to supersede, nullify or otherwise affect 51 Pa.C.S. §
- 22 9603 (relating to participation goal). In the case of an
- 23 inconsistency between this section and 51 Pa.C.S. Ch. 96
- 24 (relating to veteran-owned small businesses), the provisions of
- 25 51 Pa.C.S. Ch. 96 shall prevail.
- 26 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
