## AN ACT

4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Title 34 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
7	Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
8	<u>§ 2902.1. Permit exemptions.</u>
9	(a) ProhibitionNotwithstanding any other provision of
10	this title, the holder of a permit-exempt license may not be
11	required to obtain a permit to hunt a species that the holder of
12	the permit-exempt license was allowed to hunt without a permit
13	prior to July 1, 2017.
14	(b) DefinitionsAs used in this section, the following
15	words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
16	subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:
17	"Permit-exempt license." Any of the following:

1	(1) A senior lifetime resident hunting license.
2	(2) A senior lifetime resident combination hunting and
3	<u>furtaker license.</u>
4	Section 2. The addition of 34 Pa.C.S. § 2902.1 shall apply
5	retroactively to July 1, 2017.

6 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
