AN ACT

- Providing for the Commonwealth Advisory Board on Geographic Names; and imposing duties on the Commonwealth Advisory Board
- on Geographic Names.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Short title.
- 7 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Commonwealth
- 8 Advisory Board on Geographic Names Act.
- 9 Section 2. Legislative intent.
- 10 The General Assembly finds and declares as follows:
- 11 (1) Certain geographic location names in this
- 12 Commonwealth are offensive and insulting to this
- 13 Commonwealth's residents, history and heritage.
- 14 (2) These geographic location names should be replaced
- by names that better reflect this Commonwealth's residents,
- 16 history and heritage without resorting to harmful or
- offensive stereotypes, names, words or phrases.
- 18 (3) The United States Board on Geographic Names, the

- 1 Federal agency which determines official geographic location
- 2 name changes, is a reactive body and does not initiate name
- 3 proposals, only accepting proposals from Federal, State,
- 4 local and tribal agencies, as well as from local
- 5 organizations and private citizens.
- 6 (4) The process by which the Federal Government follows
- 7 to make official changes to geographic location names is
- 8 burdensome, complicated and lengthy.
- 9 (5) The establishment of the Commonwealth Advisory Board
- on Geographic Names to address certain geographic location
- 11 names in this Commonwealth will be beneficial in identifying
- offensive and insulting geographic location names and
- assisting the Commonwealth and local governments, as well as
- 14 local organizations and private citizens, in the burdensome
- process of proposing changes to geographic location names in
- 16 this Commonwealth.
- 17 Section 3. Definitions.
- 18 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 19 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 20 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 21 "Board." The Commonwealth Advisory Board on Geographic
- 22 Names.
- "Department." The Department of Conservation and Natural
- 24 Resources of the Commonwealth.
- 25 Section 4. Commonwealth Advisory Board on Geographic Names.
- 26 (a) Establishment.--The Commonwealth Advisory Board on
- 27 Geographic Names is established within the department.
- 28 (b) Purpose. -- The board shall facilitate discussion among
- 29 its membership to consider issues related to geographic location
- 30 names, make recommendations to the appropriate Federal, State

- 1 and local agencies and assist the Commonwealth and local
- 2 governments, including local organizations and private citizens,
- 3 in the process of proposing changes to geographic location
- 4 names.
- 5 (c) Members.--The board shall be composed of the following
- 6 members:
- 7 (1) The Secretary of Conservation and Natural Resources
- 8 or the secretary's designee.
- 9 (2) The Secretary of Environmental Protection or the
- 10 secretary's designee.
- 11 (3) The Secretary of Transportation or the secretary's
- designee.
- 13 (4) One member of the Senate appointed by the President
- 14 pro Tempore of the Senate.
- 15 (5) One member of the Senate appointed by the Majority
- 16 Leader of the Senate.
- 17 (6) One member of the Senate appointed by the Minority
- 18 Leader of the Senate.
- 19 (7) One member of the House of Representatives appointed
- 20 by the Speaker of the House of Representatives.
- 21 (8) One member of the House of Representatives appointed
- 22 by the Majority Leader of the House of Representatives.
- 23 (9) One member of the House of Representatives appointed
- 24 by the Minority Leader of the House of Representatives.
- 25 (10) A representative from the Historical Society of
- Pennsylvania, appointed by the Governor.
- 27 (11) A representative from the Pennsylvania State
- 28 Archives, appointed by the Governor.
- 29 (c) Chairs. -- The board shall elect a chair and vice chair
- 30 from among its membership.

- 1 (d) Term.--Except members under subsection (c)(1), (2), (3),
- 2 all members of the board shall serve a term of three years and
- 3 may serve on the board until a successor is appointed.
- 4 (e) Compensation. -- Members of the board shall receive no
- 5 compensation for service on the board but shall be reimbursed
- 6 for expenses incurred in the performance of their duties under
- 7 this act.
- 8 (f) Staff support.--The department shall provide staff
- 9 support to the board.
- 10 Section 5. Duties of board.
- 11 The board shall:
- 12 (1) Meet at least once a year to consider issues related
- to geographic location names and make recommendations to the
- 14 appropriate Federal, State and local agencies for proposed
- 15 geographic location name changes.
- 16 (2) Develop a process to assist the Commonwealth and
- 17 local governments, including local organizations and private
- 18 citizens of this Commonwealth, in the process of
- 19 proposing changes to a geographic location name.
- 20 (3) Develop educational materials and outreach
- 21 opportunities for the department to make available regarding
- the purpose and mission of the board.
- 23 (4) Issue an annual report detailing recommendations or
- 24 actions made by the board. The annual report shall be
- submitted to the chair and minority chair of the State
- 26 Government Committee of the Senate and the chair and minority
- 27 chair of the State Government Committee of the House of
- 28 Representatives by December 1, 2018, and by December 1 of
- 29 each year thereafter.
- 30 Section 6. Effective date.

1 This act shall take effect in 90 days.
