## AN ACT

- Designating a bridge, identified as Bridge Key 35000, on that portion of State Route 2040 over Pigeon Creek in Bentleyville Borough, Washington County, as the Mrs. Madeline Finney
- 4 Memorial Bridge.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Mrs. Madeline Finney Memorial Bridge.
- 8 (a) Findings.--The General Assembly finds and declares as
- 9 follows:
- 10 (1) In 1966, Mrs. Madeline (Madge) Finney decided that
- something must be done about a small bridge, built in 1908,
- 12 to span Pigeon Creek, in her town of Bentleyville,
- 13 Pennsylvania, that was simply too small for what was then
- "modern traffic."
- 15 (2) Mrs. Finney recognized how unsafe the bridge was for
- the more than 60 children that crossed the bridge twice daily
- 17 to go to and from school, including six of her own children.
- 18 (3) Mrs. Finney spearheaded the four-year campaign to
- 19 expand the bridge.

- 1 (4) In a letter to then State Senator William J. Lane,
- 2 she wrote, "I do not intend to let this Highway Department
- 3 have any peace until something is done about this bridge."
- 4 (5) Mrs. Finney also oversaw a letter writing campaign
- of 95 children and numerous adults to Governor William
- 6 Scranton.
- 7 (6) The bridge expansion was completed in 1970.
- 8 (7) Mrs. Finney died on July 12, 2020.
- 9 (b) Designation. -- The bridge, identified as Bridge Key
- 10 35000, on that portion of State Route 2040 over Pigeon Creek in
- 11 Bentleyville Borough, Washington County, is designated the Mrs.
- 12 Madeline Finney Memorial Bridge.
- 13 (c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and
- 14 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the bridge to
- 15 traffic in both directions on the bridge.
- 16 Section 2. Effective date.
- 17 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
