AN ACT

Amending the act of December 5, 1936 (2nd Sp.Sess., 1937 P.L.2897, No.1), entitled "An act establishing a system of 2 unemployment compensation to be administered by the 3 Department of Labor and Industry and its existing and newly created agencies with personnel (with certain exceptions) 4 5 selected on a civil service basis; requiring employers to 6 keep records and make reports, and certain employers to pay contributions based on payrolls to provide moneys for the 8 payment of compensation to certain unemployed persons; 9 providing procedure and administrative details for the 10 determination, payment and collection of such contributions 11 12 and the payment of such compensation; providing for cooperation with the Federal Government and its agencies; 13 creating certain special funds in the custody of the State 14 Treasurer; and prescribing penalties," in compensation, 15 further providing for qualifications required to secure 16 17 compensation. 18 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 19 hereby enacts as follows: 20 Section 1. Section 401(b)(1)(iii) of the act of December 5, 21 1936 (2nd Sp.Sess., 1937 P.L.2897, No.1), known as the 22 Unemployment Compensation Law, is amended to read: 23 Section 401. Qualifications Required to Secure

Compensation. -- Compensation shall be payable to any employe who

- 1 is or becomes unemployed, and who--
- 2 * * *
- 3 (b) (1) Is making an active search for suitable employment.
- 4 The requirements for "active search" shall be established by the
- 5 department and shall include, at a minimum, all of the
- 6 following:
- 7 * * *
- 8 (iii) Applying for positions that offer employment and wages
- 9 similar to those the claimant had prior to his unemployment and
- 10 which are within a forty-five (45) minute commuting distance.
- 11 The following apply:
- 12 (A) A claimant shall make a good-faith effort to obtain
- 13 employment in suitable work. A claimant who has applied for a
- 14 position may not take any action to unreasonably discourage the
- 15 claimant's own hire in suitable work, including any of the
- 16 following:
- 17 (I) Refusing to attend or failing to participate, WITHOUT <--
- 18 GOOD CAUSE, in a job interview or other applicant selection
- 19 <u>activity offered by the employer without good cause.</u> <--
- 20 (II) Refusing employment or a referral for employment,
- 21 without good cause, prior to an interview or a discussion of the
- 22 <u>details of a job with the employer.</u>
- 23 (B) Within 90 days of the effective date of this
- 24 subparagraph, the department shall create forms or update
- 25 <u>existing forms to enable employers to report claimants who</u>
- 26 discourage their own hire, as provided in this subclause. The
- 27 forms shall include notice of the provisions of section 802.
- 28 (C) A claimant who unreasonably discourages the claimant's
- 29 own hire in suitable work shall be considered to have refused an
- 30 offer of work for purposes of section 402(a).
