- 3 "De minimis impact project." The construction, maintenance,
- 4 testing, repair, rehabilitation or replacement of water
- 5 obstructions and encroachments that create a disturbance that
- 6 <u>affects an area not larger than 1/20 of an acre located within a</u>
- 7 floodway.
- 8 § 3302. De minimis impact project permits.
- 9 The fee for a permit under 25 Pa. Code Ch. 105 (relating to
- 10 dam safety and waterway management) for a de minimis impact
- 11 project is \$100.
- 12 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
