| 4  | (a) Fund establishedThe Driver Distraction Awareness Fund        |
| 5  | is established in the Motor License Fund as a special restricted |

| 7  | under section 3714(c.1) (relating to careless driving), Federal  |
| 8  | funds granted for careless driving prevention and any money      |
| 9  | donated to the fund. The fund shall be used solely for the       |
