AN ACT

Amending the act of December 20, 1985 (P.L.457, No.112), entitled "An act relating to the right to practice medicine 2 and surgery and the right to practice medically related acts; 3 reestablishing the State Board of Medical Education and Licensure as the State Board of Medicine and providing for its composition, powers and duties; providing for the issuance of licenses and certificates and the suspension and revocation of licenses and certificates; provided penalties; and making repeals," further providing for institutional license; and abrogating a related regulation. 10 11 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 12 hereby enacts as follows: 13 Section 1. Section 32 of the act of December 20, 1985 14 (P.L.457, No.112), known as the Medical Practice Act of 1985, is amended by adding a subsection to read: 15 Section 32. Institutional license. 16 * * * 17 18 (d) Authorization. -- Notwithstanding 49 Pa. Code § 17.3(d) 19 (relating to institutional license), a licensee may practice at 20 more than two affiliated facilities when practicing or teaching under an institutional license. 2.1
