AN ACT

Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania 1 Consolidated Statutes, in assault, providing for the offense 2 of unauthorized implantation of microchip. 3 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 5 hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read: § 2719. Unauthorized implantation of microchip. 8 9 (a) Offense defined. -- A person commits an offense if the 10 person implants or causes to be implanted a microchip or other device containing radio frequency identification technology 11 12 within another person's body without the prior written consent 13 of the other person. 14 (b) Public officers.--15 (1) No court, judge, executive officer, administrative 16 agency or public employee of the Commonwealth or of any local

governmental body shall have power to issue any order

requiring a person to have a microchip or other device

- 12 <u>of subsection</u> (b) <u>is a misdemeanor of the first degree.</u>
- 13 (d) Definition.--As used in this section, the term "radio
- 14 frequency identification technology" means a wireless
- 15 <u>identification system that uses an electromagnetic radio</u>
- 16 <u>frequency signal to transmit data.</u>
- 17 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
