13	(3) Except as provided otherwise in this section, no
14	nonprofit organization under section 501(c)(3), (4) or (6) of
15	the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 shall be liable for an act
16	or omission of any person acting as a volunteer for the
17	nonprofit organization unless the nonprofit organization
18	would be liable for the act or omission under generally
19	applicable laws governing the direct or vicarious liability

of nonprofit organizations and the nonprofit organization
expressly authorized the specific act or omission that

3 produced the harm.

4 (b) Exceptions.--

5 (1) Nothing in this section shall be construed as 6 affecting or modifying the liability of such person <u>or</u> 7 <u>nonprofit organization</u> for acts or omissions relating to the 8 transportation of participants in a public service program or 9 project or others to or from a public service program or 10 project.

11 (2) Nothing in this section shall be construed as 12 affecting or modifying any existing legal basis for 13 determining the liability, or any defense thereto, of any 14 person <u>or nonprofit organization</u> not covered by the standard 15 of negligence established by this section.

16 (c) Assumption of risk or contributory fault.--Nothing in 17 this section shall be construed as affecting or modifying the 18 doctrine of assumption of risk or contributory fault on the part 19 of the participant <u>or nonprofit organization</u>.
