## AN ACT

- Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," in pupils and attendance, providing
- laws relating thereto," in pupils and attendance, providing for evaluation of potentially hazardous walking routes; and
- 7 imposing duties on the Department of Transportation.
- 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 9 hereby enacts as follows:
- 10 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
- 11 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a
- 12 section to read:
- 13 <u>Section 1368. Evaluation of Potentially Hazardous Walking</u>
- 14 Routes.--(a) The department shall develop a form for members of
- 15 the public, including students and parents and guardians of
- 16 students, to request that a school district contact the
- 17 <u>department to evaluate potentially hazardous walking routes for</u>
- 18 students on their way to and from a school in the school
- 19 <u>district</u>. The following apply:
- 20 <u>(1) The form shall be:</u>

- 1 (i) Provided by the department and the school district in
- 2 <u>hard copy form upon request.</u>
- 3 (ii) Posted on the publicly accessible Internet website of
- 4 the department and the school district.
- 5 (2) The form shall:
- 6 (i) Require the name, address, telephone number and other
- 7 contact information of the requestor completing the form.
- 8 (ii) Contain space for a full description of the potentially
- 9 <u>hazardous walking route.</u>
- 10 (iii) Allow for the submittal of any available photographs
- 11 of the potentially hazardous walking route.
- 12 (b) A school district that receives a completed form under
- 13 subsection (a) shall notify the requestor regarding whether or
- 14 not the school district has determined that the department
- 15 should be contacted to evaluate the potentially hazardous
- 16 <u>walking route. If the school district determines that the</u>
- 17 department should not be so contacted, the school district shall
- 18 inform the requestor of the reason for that determination.
- (c) As used in this section, the following words and phrases
- 20 shall have the meanings given to them in this subsection unless
- 21 the context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 22 "Department." The Department of Transportation of the
- 23 Commonwealth.
- 24 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
