AN ACT

Amending Titles 30 (Fish) and 34 (Game) of the Pennsylvania 1 Consolidated Statutes, in preliminary provisions relating to 2 fishing and boating, further providing for definitions; in 3 Pennsylvania Fish and Boat Commission, further providing for 4 executive director and providing for audits; in enforcement, 5 further providing for enforcement of other laws and for 6 delegation of enforcement powers and providing for 7 interagency agreement; in preliminary provisions relating to 8 game and wildlife, further providing for definitions; and, in 9 10 Pennsylvania Game Commission, further providing for director, providing for joint director and for audits and further 11 providing for cooperative agreements. 12 13 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 14 hereby enacts as follows: 15 Section 1. The definition of "executive director" in section 102 of Title 30 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is 16 amended to read: 17 § 102. Definitions. 18 19 Subject to additional definitions contained in subsequent 20 provisions of this title which are applicable to specific 21 provisions of this title, the following words and phrases when 22 used in this title shall have, unless the context clearly 23 indicates otherwise, the meanings given to them in this section:

2 "Executive director." The <u>individual appointed under 34</u>
3 <u>Pa.C.S. § 302.1 (relating to joint director) to perform the</u>
4 <u>powers and duties as</u> executive director of the Pennsylvania Fish

9 (a) Appointment and compensation.--

The [commission shall appoint to serve at its 10 (1)pleasure and, with the approval of the Governor, fix the 11 12 compensation of an executive director who] individual 13 appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the 14 Senate under 34 Pa.C.S. § 302.1 (relating to joint director) 15 shall [be] act as the chief executive officer of the commission and attend to its administrative work and shall 16 17 have charge of all activities under the jurisdiction of the 18 commission. The executive director shall be the chief 19 waterways patrolman of the commission and shall have charge 20 of, direct, supervise, and control all waterways patrolmen, 21 deputy waterways patrolmen and employees of the commission. 22 [No member of the commission nor any person who has served as 23 a member thereof within one year shall be eligible for 24 appointment as executive director.]

25 (2) The individual appointed by the commission and
26 acting as the executive director on the effective date of
27 this paragraph shall cease to serve in that capacity as of
28 the date the Governor appoints the joint director under 34
