AN ACT

Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 1 Statutes, in registration of vehicles, further providing for 2 person with disability plate and placard; and, in rules of 3 the road in general, further providing for additional parking regulations. 5 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 7 hereby enacts as follows: 8 Section 1. Section 1338(d) of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read: § 1338. Person with disability plate and placard. 10 11 12 (d) Penalty. -- Any person violating this section commits a summary offense and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay 13 14 a fine [of not more than \$100.] as follows: 15 (1) Two hundred fifty dollars for a first offense. 16 (2) Five hundred dollars for a second offense. (3) Seven hundred fifty dollars for a third or 17

subsequent offense.

- 2 Section 2. Section 3354(d)(3)(i) and (f) of Title 75 are
- 3 amended and the section is amended by adding a subsection to

- 5 § 3354. Additional parking regulations.

- 7 (d) Person with a disability and disabled veterans.--
- 8 * * *
- 9 (3) (i) Except for persons parking vehicles lawfully
- 10 bearing a person with a disability or severely disabled
- 11 veteran registration plate or displaying a person with a
- disability or severely disabled veteran parking placard when
- such vehicles are being operated by or for the transportation
- of a person with a disability or a severely disabled veteran,
- no person shall park a vehicle on public or private property
- reserved for a person with a disability or severely disabled
- 17 veteran which property has been so posted in accordance with
- 18 departmental regulations. Regulations shall require that
- 19 parking spaces designated with an international symbol for
- 20 access for persons with disabilities on a sign are posted
- 21 with a sign stating the penalty amount indicated in
- 22 subsection (f) and that vehicles in violation of the
- 23 subsection may be towed and require that signs be replaced
- 24 when they become either obsolete or missing with all costs to
- 25 replace the necessary signs to be borne by the persons
- responsible for signing the particular location. The sign
- 27 <u>shall state, in effect, if you see a vehicle parking in this</u>
- 28 space that does not bear a person with a disability or
- 29 <u>severely disabled veteran registration plate or displaying a</u>
- 30 person with a disability or severely disabled veteran parking

- 1 placard, call the toll-free telephone number established or
- 2 <u>designated under subsection (d.1).</u> The absence of a sign
- 3 stating the penalty amount at parking spaces designated with
- 4 an international symbol for access for persons with
- 5 disabilities shall not preclude the enforcement of this
- 6 subsection. A vehicle which is unlawfully parked in a
- 7 designated person with a disability parking area may be
- 8 removed from that area by towing and may be reclaimed by the
- 9 vehicle owner upon payment of the towing costs. A vehicle may
- only be towed under this paragraph if the parking space is
- 11 posted with a sign indicating that vehicles in violation of
- 12 this section may be towed.

- 14 (d.1) Hotline. -- The department shall establish or designate
- 15 a toll-free telephone number to report violations under
- 16 subsection (e).
- 17 * * *
- 18 (f) Penalty. -- A person violating subsection (a), (b) or (d)
- 19 (1) is guilty of a summary offense and shall, upon conviction,
- 20 be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than \$15. A person
- 21 violating subsection (d)(2) or (3) or (e) is guilty of a summary
- 22 offense and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine
- 23 [of not less than \$50 nor more than \$200.] as follows:
- 24 (1) Two hundred fifty dollars for a first offense.
- 25 (2) Five hundred dollars for a second offense.
- 26 (3) Seven hundred fifty dollars for a third or
- 27 <u>subsequent offense.</u>
- 28 If a person is convicted under subsection (d)(2) or (3) in the
- 29 absence of a sign stating the penalty amount, the fine imposed
- 30 may not exceed \$50.

- 2 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
