## AN ACT

Amending Title 40 (Insurance) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 1 Statutes, providing for notification requirements for older 2 adult health insurance policies. The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 4 hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. Title 40 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a chapter to read: 8 CHAPTER 45 9 NOTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS FOR 10 OLDER ADULT HEALTH INSURANCE POLICIES 11 Sec. 12 4501. Definitions. 13 4502. Power of attorney notification. 14 § 4501. Definitions. 15 The following words and phrases when used in this chapter 16 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the

context clearly indicates otherwise:

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- 1 <u>"Agent." A person designated in a power of attorney.</u>
- 2 "Health insurance policy." As defined in section 4001
- 3 (relating to definitions).
- 4 <u>"Older adult." An individual in this Commonwealth who is 60</u>
- 5 years of age or older.
- 6 § 4502. Power of attorney notification.
- 7 <u>(a) Duties of insurer.--An insurer shall:</u>
- 8 (1) If an older adult is enrolling in a health insurance
- 9 policy, ask the older adult if the older adult has a power of
- 10 attorney which provides for health care decision making and
- 11 request the older adult provide the name and contact
- 12 <u>information of the agent.</u>
- 13 (2) Inform the older adult that the purpose of
- 14 <u>collecting the information under paragraph (1) is to provide</u>
- the agent with notification of the older adult enrolling in
- or canceling a health insurance policy.
- 17 (3) If the insurer has an agent on file for an older
- 18 adult, notify the agent in writing if the older adult enrolls
- in or cancels a health insurance policy and send a copy of
- the notification to the older adult. The notification shall
- 21 inform the older adult of the rescission period under
- 22 subsection (b) and the effect of invoking the right of
- 23 rescission.
- 24 (b) Rescission period. -- If an agent is notified as provided
- 25 under subsection (a), the older adult has the right, within 30
- 26 days, to rescind enrollment in or cancellation of the health
- 27 <u>insurance policy without penalty.</u>
- 28 (c) Revocation of power of attorney. -- If an older adult
- 29 <u>revokes a power of attorney and notifies the insurer of the</u>
- 30 revocation, the duties of the insurer under subsection (a) shall

- 1 not apply.
- 2 (d) Defense. -- Good faith reliance on the information
- 3 provided by an older adult shall be a complete defense to any
- 4 civil or criminal action brought against an insurer based on
- 5 actions taken by the insurer under this section.
- 6 Section 2. This act shall apply to enrollments and
- 7 cancellations of health insurance policies by older adults that
- 8 occur after the effective date of this section.
- 9 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
