AN ACT

- Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," in terms and courses of study, providing for alternative instruction without technology.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
- 10 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a
- 11 section to read:
- 12 Section 1528. Alternative Instruction Without Technology.--
- 13 (a) Upon receipt of a written request from a child's parent or
- 14 quardian to have the child excused from specific instruction in
- 15 which the child is required to use technology, a school entity
- 16 shall provide the child with alternative instruction that does
- 17 not require the child to use technology.
- (b) As used in this section, the following words and phrases
- 19 <u>shall have the meanings given to them in this subsection unless</u>
- 20 the context clearly indicates otherwise:

- 1 <u>"School entity." A public school district, intermediate</u>
- 2 <u>unit, area vocational-technical school, charter school or</u>
- 3 <u>regional charter school.</u>
- 4 "Technology." Any equipment by means of which a user is
- 5 provided with access to the Internet.
- 6 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
