## AN ACT

1 2 3 4 5 6	Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," in preliminary provisions, providing for study of secondary school start times.
7	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
8	hereby enacts as follows:
9	Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
10	as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a
11	section to read:
12	Section 113.1. Study of Secondary School Start Times(a)
13	The Department of Education shall conduct a study of issues,
14	benefits and options related to instituting a later start time
15	to the school day in secondary schools. The study shall:
16	(1) consider the recent recommendations of the American
17	Academy of Pediatrics on the establishment of later school start
18	times;
19	(2) include an assessment of the health, academic and safety

1	benefits associated with establishing later start times for
2	<pre>secondary schools;</pre>
3	(3) include an assessment of the effects of blue light from
4	electronics on sleep and how later school start times for
5	secondary schools may impact those effects;
6	(4) evaluate any potential negative impacts on school
7	districts and families that may be associated with a later
8	school start time and consider strategies for addressing
9	potential problems;
10	(5) review all available literature and data on the
11	experiences of school districts in other states that have
12	instituted later school start times; and
13	(6) include a recommendation relating to the advisability of
14	establishing a pilot program to test later school start times in
15	select secondary schools in this Commonwealth that are
16	interested in participating in the program.
17	(b) The Department of Education shall prepare a report that
18	includes its findings and recommendations from the study and
19	shall provide the report to the chairman and minority chairman
20	of the Education Committee of the Senate and the chairman and
21	minority chairman of the Education Committee of the House of
22	Representatives no later than six months after the effective
23	date of this section.
24	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.

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
