Lost, stolen, damaged or illegible registration plate. 8 * * * 9 10 (b.1) Illegible registration plate. --11 The department may reissue a registration plate upon (1) 12 request by a registrant when it is determined by an 13 authorized representative of the department or law 14 enforcement that the registration plate is illegible from a 15 reasonable distance. The department may select the style of 16 the reissued registration plate and, except in the case of 17 personal registration plates issued under section 1341
