AN ACT

1 Amending the act of January 17, 1968 (P.L.11, No.5), entitled
2 "An act establishing a fixed minimum wage and overtime rates
3 for employes, with certain exceptions; providing for minimum
4 rates for learners and apprentices; creating a Minimum Wage
5 Advisory Board and defining its powers and duties; conferring
6 powers and imposing duties upon the Department of Labor and
7 Industry; imposing duties on employers; and providing
8 penalties," repealing preemption provision.

9 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
10 hereby enacts as follows:

11 Section 1. Section 14.1 of the act of January 17, 1968
12 (P.L.11, No.5), known as The Minimum Wage Act of 1968, added
13 July 9, 2006 (P.L.1077, No.112), is repealed:

14 [Section 14.1. Preemption.--(a) Except as set forth in
15 subsection (b), this act shall preempt and supersede any local
16 ordinance or rule concerning the subject matter of this act.

17 (b) This section does not prohibit local regulation pursuant
18 to an ordinance which was adopted by a municipality prior to
19 January 1, 2006, and which remained in effect on January 1,
20 2006.]

1 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
