3	The	following	words	and	phrases	when	used	in	this	subchapter	2

4 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the

5 <u>context clearly indicates otherwise:</u>

6 <u>"Municipal corporation." A city, county, borough, township,</u>

7 incorporated town or municipal authority.

8 "Public notice." Notice published once each week for two

9 <u>successive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation.</u>

10 § 5212. Sale or lease of water or sewer system.

11 In addition to the provisions of 65 Pa.C.S. Ch. 7 (relating

12 to open meetings), prior to entering into an agreement to sell

13 or lease a water or sewer system owned or operated by a

14 municipal corporation, the municipal corporation shall hold at

15 least one advertised public meeting and shall provide public

16 notice of the meeting in all municipalities served by the water

17 <u>or sewer system.</u>

18 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
