AN ACT

Amending the act of May 17, 1921 (P.L.682, No.284), entitled "An act relating to insurance; amending, revising, and 2 consolidating the law providing for the incorporation of 3 insurance companies, and the regulation, supervision, and protection of home and foreign insurance companies, Lloyds associations, reciprocal and inter-insurance exchanges, and fire insurance rating bureaus, and the regulation and 7 supervision of insurance carried by such companies, 8 9 associations, and exchanges, including insurance carried by the State Workmen's Insurance Fund; providing penalties; and 10 repealing existing laws," in automobile insurance issuance, renewal, cancellation and refusal, providing for insurance 11 12 rates for law enforcement officers and emergency responders. 13 14 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 15 hereby enacts as follows: 16 Section 1. The act of May 17, 1921 (P.L.682, No.284), known 17 as The Insurance Company Law of 1921, is amended by adding a section to read: 18 19 Section 2005.1. Insurance Rates for Law Enforcement Officers 20 and Emergency Responders. -- (a) An insurer may not increase the 21 premium for a policy of automobile insurance to a law 22 enforcement officer or an emergency responder on the basis of any accident involving a motor vehicle operated by the law 23

- 1 <u>enforcement officer or emergency responder if:</u>
- 2 (1) the accident occurred while the law enforcement officer
- 3 or emergency responder was operating the motor vehicle in the
- 4 performance of the law enforcement officer's or emergency
- 5 <u>responder's duties or in response to a 911 call; and</u>
- 6 (2) there is a policy of insurance other than the policy of
- 7 <u>automobile insurance providing motor vehicle liability or</u>
- 8 <u>collision coverage for the accident.</u>
- 9 (b) Effect. -- This section shall in no way restrict the
- 10 premium which an insurer may charge a governmental entity for an
- 11 <u>insurance policy providing motor vehicle liability or collision</u>
- 12 <u>insurance covering law enforcement officers or emergency</u>
- 13 <u>responders.</u>
- (c) Definitions. -- As used in this section, the following
- 15 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 16 <u>subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:</u>
- "Emergency responder." As the term is defined in 35 Pa.C.S.
- 18 § 7332 (relating to definitions).
- "Law enforcement officer." As the term is defined in 42
- 20 Pa.C.S. § 5950(d) (relating to confidential communications
- 21 <u>involving law enforcement officers</u>).
- 22 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
