5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Section 6152.1(a) of Title 42 of the Pennsylvania
7	Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a paragraph to read:
8	§ 6152.1. Limit on charges.
9	(a) Charges
10	* * *
11	(3) Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the
12	contrary, a health care provider or facility shall provide
13	without charge one complete copy of a patient's medical
14	charts and records if all of the following apply:
15	(i) The patient is a veteran, as defined in 51
16	Pa.C.S. § 7202 (relating to definitions), and is indigent

1	and homeless.
2	(ii) The medical charts and records are being
3	requested by the patient or a person presenting a valid
4	authorization for the release of the medical charts and
5	records that is signed by the patient or the patient's
6	legally authorized representative.
7	(iii) The medical charts and records are being
8	sought for the purpose of supporting a claim for Federal
9	veterans' disability benefits.
