## AN ACT

7	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
8	hereby enacts as follows:
9	Section 1. Section 1309-B(c) of the act of March 10, 1949
10	(P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, is
11	amended by adding a paragraph to read:
12	Section 1309-B. School safety and security coordinator.

14	(c) Specific dutiesThe school safety and security
15	coordinator shall:

17	(7) Consider the implementation of a panic alarm system
18	as part of the school safety and security coordinator's
19	review of the school entity's policies and procedures under

1	paragraph (1). As used in this paragraph, the term "panic
2	<u>alarm system" shall mean a silent security system signal</u>
3	generated by the manual activation of a device, including a
4	wired panic button, wireless panic button or mobile or
5	computer application, intended to signal a life-threatening
6	or emergency situation requiring a response from local law
7	enforcement or, in the case of a school building located in a
8	municipality where there is no municipal police department, a
9	location designated by the Commissioner of Pennsylvania State
10	Police.

12	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
