AN ACT

1	Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), entitled
2	"An act providing for and reorganizing the conduct of the
3	executive and administrative work of the Commonwealth by the
4	Executive Department thereof and the administrative
5	departments, boards, commissions, and officers thereof,
6	including the boards of trustees of State Normal Schools, or
7	Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, reorganizing or
8	authorizing the reorganization of certain administrative
9	departments, boards, and commissions; defining the powers and
10	duties of the Governor and other executive and administrative
11	officers, and of the several administrative departments,
12	boards, commissions, and officers; fixing the salaries of the
13	Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain other executive
14	and administrative officers; providing for the appointment of
15	certain administrative officers, and of all deputies and
16	other assistants and employes in certain departments, boards,
17	and commissions; and prescribing the manner in which the
18	number and compensation of the deputies and all other
19	assistants and employes of certain departments, boards and
20	commissions shall be determined," in Commonwealth budget
21	procedures, providing for general appropriation bill
22	compensation suspension.
23	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
24	hereby enacts as follows:
25	Section 1. The act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), known
26	as The Administrative Code of 1929, is amended by adding a

1	Section 613.1. General Appropriation Bill Compensation
2	Suspension(a) If the General Assembly fails to pass, or the
3	Governor vetoes, a general appropriation bill for a fiscal year,
4	compensation and reimbursement for expenses, including per
5	diems, for the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, cabinet officers
6	and members of the General Assembly shall be suspended until a
7	general appropriation bill has been passed by the General
8	Assembly and signed by the Governor.
9	(b) Compensation and reimbursement for expenses, including
10	per diems, shall be paid retroactively to the Governor,
11	Lieutenant Governor, cabinet officer or member of the General
12	Assembly for any service rendered between July 1 and the
