Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania

Consolidated Statutes, in firearms and other dangerous 2 articles, providing for prohibited conduct during public 3 demonstrations. 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 7 Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a section to read: § 6107.1. Prohibited conduct during public demonstrations. 10 (a) General rule. -- Notwithstanding any other provision of 11 this chapter or any other law or regulation to the contrary, no person, other than a person enumerated in section 6106(b)(1), 12 (2), (3) and (13) (relating to firearms not to be carried 13 without a license), may: 14 15 (1) have in the person's possession, or immediate access 16 to, including in any vehicle, a firearm or other dangerous 17 article while participating in or attending a public demonstration held at a public place in this Commonwealth; or 18

- 10 (b) Exception.--This section shall not apply to a person in
- 11 possession of any firearm or other dangerous article in a
- 12 private dwelling or place of business.
- (c) Penalty. -- A person who violates this section commits a
- 14 <u>felony of the third degree.</u>
- 15 (d) Definitions. -- As used in this section, the following
- 16 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 17 subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 18 "Dangerous article." The term shall include any offensive
- 19 weapon, as defined under section 908 (relating to prohibited
- 20 offensive weapons), and a hatchet, ax, slingshot, nightstick,
- 21 mace, pepper spray, iron buckle, baseball bat, ax handle,
- 22 chains, crowbar, hammer or other club or bludgeon or any other
- 23 weapon or instrument customarily used or intended for probable
- 24 use as an offensive weapon.
- 25 "Firearm." As defined under section 908, whether the firearm
- 26 is loaded or unloaded. The term shall include an air rifle or
- 27 air pistol.
- 28 "Law enforcement officer." A duly appointed and acting
- 29 Federal, State or local peace officer who, by virtue of the
- 30 officer's office or public employment, is vested by law with the

- 1 duty to maintain public order or to make arrests for offenses or
- 2 any person on active State duty under 51 Pa.C.S. § 508 (relating
- 3 to active duty for emergency).
- 4 <u>"Public demonstration."</u> The assembly of two or more persons
- 5 for the purpose of picketing, speechmaking, marching, holding
- 6 <u>vigils or other form of conduct or civil discourse that has the</u>
- 7 <u>effect</u>, intent or propensity to attract other individuals or
- 8 onlookers, regardless of whether a political subdivision has
- 9 issued a permit authorizing the demonstration.
- 10 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
