## AN ACT

1 2 3 4 5 6	Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," providing for Diversity Inclusive Curriculum Pilot Program.
7	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
8	hereby enacts as follows:
9	Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
10	as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding an
11	article to read:
12	<u>ARTICLE XVII-E</u>
13	DIVERSITY INCLUSIVE CURRICULUM PILOT PROGRAM
14	<u>Section 1701-E. Scope of article.</u>
15	This article establishes the Diversity Inclusive Curriculum
16	<u>Pilot Program.</u>
17	<u>Section 1702-E. Definitions.</u>
18	The following words and phrases when used in this article
19	shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the

1	context clearly indicates otherwise:
2	"Department." The Department of Education of the
3	Commonwealth.
4	"LGBTQ+." Lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, queer,
5	asexual, intersex or other similar characteristic of an
6	individual.
7	"Pilot program." The Diversity Inclusive Curriculum Pilot
8	Program established under this article.
9	"School entity." A school district, charter school, regional
10	charter school, cyber charter school, intermediate unit or area
11	career and technical school.
12	Section 1703-E. Diversity Inclusive Curriculum Pilot Program.
13	(a) EstablishmentThe Diversity Inclusive Curriculum Pilot
14	Program is established in the department to provide instruction
15	to students on the political, economic and social contributions
16	of individuals of the LGBTQ+ community.
17	(b) OperationThe pilot program shall operate for three
18	full school years, beginning with the 2024-2025 school year.
19	(c) Selection of school entities
20	(1) By July 15, 2024, the department may select school
21	entities and nonpublic schools to participate in the pilot
22	program.
23	(2) To be eligible for the pilot program, a school
24	entity or nonpublic school must submit a proposal to the
25	department by May 15, 2024, that identifies how the school
26	entity or nonpublic school will meet the guidelines
27	established by the department for the pilot program.
28	Section 1704-E. Department responsibilities.
29	(a) FundingThe department may use Federal, State and
30	other money to the extent that it is made available for the

2	(b) ConsultationNo later than six months after the	
3	effective date of this subsection, the department shall consult_	
4	with professional organizations operating in this Commonwealth	
5	that serve diverse populations, including LGBTQ+ individuals in	
6	establishing, operating and evaluating the pilot program.	
7	(c) GuidelinesBy March 15, 2024, the department shall	
8	establish guidelines and procedures for the pilot program in	
9	consultation with professional organizations that serve diverse	
10	populations, including LGBTQ+ individuals. The department shall	
11	consider curriculum offered by organizations with 50% or greater	
12	LGBTQ+ leadership that specialize in and have expertise with	
13	LGBTQ+ individuals before selecting the curriculum to be used	
14	for the pilot program.	
15	<u>Section 1705-E. Pilot program evaluation.</u>	
16	(a) Report by school entitiesA participating school	
17	entity or nonpublic school shall annually report to the	
18	department data and information about the operation of the pilot	
19	program, in the manner prescribed by the department. At a	
20	minimum, a participating school entity or nonpublic school shall	
21	annually report to the department about how the participating	
22	school entity or nonpublic school met the objectives of the	
23	pilot program and any difficulty encountered in seeking to meet	
24	the objectives of the pilot program.	
25	(b) EvaluationThe department shall contract with a	
26	nationally recognized educational evaluation institution or	
27	organization to provide an evaluation of the pilot program to	
28	review the effectiveness of the implementation of a curriculum	
29	inclusive to diverse individuals. The evaluation shall be	
30	published on the department's publicly accessible Internet

2	(c) Report by departmentThe department shall compile an
3	annual report based on the data and information received about
4	the operation of the pilot program under subsection (a). The
5	department shall annually submit the report under this
6	subsection by August 1 to all of the following:
7	(1) The chair and minority chair of the Education
8	Committee of the Senate.
9	(2) The chair and minority chair of the Education
10	Committee of the House of Representatives.
11	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
