AN ACT

- Amending the act of July 10, 1981 (P.L.234, No.76), entitled "An 1 act providing limited civil and criminal immunity to persons 2 donating food to charitable or religious organizations for 3 distribution to needy persons and imposing certain powers and duties on counties," further providing for donor immunity. 5 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 7 hereby enacts as follows:
- Section 1. Section 4(b) of the act of July 10, 1981 8
- (P.L.234, No.76), known as the Donated Food Limited Liability
- 10 Act, is amended to read:
- 11 Section 4. Donor immunity.
- 12
- (b) Condition of food. -- The immunity provided by this 13
- 14 section is applicable to the good faith donation of food not
- 15 readily marketable due to considerations not [effecting]
- 16 affecting its fitness for human consumption, including, but not
- limited to, appearance, freshness, grade or surplus, but shall 17
- 18 not be deemed or construed to restrict the authority of any

- 1 authorized agency to otherwise regulate or ban the use of such
- 2 food for human consumption. The following shall apply:
- 3 (1) No person or food facility that donates food as
- 4 permitted by law may be subject to civil or criminal
- 5 <u>liability or penalty for violation of any laws, regulations</u>
- 6 or ordinances regulating the labeling or packaging of the
- 7 <u>donated product or, with respect to any other laws,</u>
- 8 <u>regulations or ordinances, for a violation occurring after</u>
- 9 <u>the time of the donation.</u>
- 10 (2) No person or food facility that donates perishable
- 11 <u>food or nonperishable food that is fit for human consumption</u>
- but has exceeded the labeled shelf life date recommended by
- the manufacturer may be subject to criminal or civil_
- liability arising from the condition of the food if the
- person that distributes the food to the end recipient makes a
- 16 good faith evaluation that the food to be donated is
- 17 wholesome in accordance with this act.
- 18 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
