AN ACT

- Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for concealing death of child.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 4303(a) of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended and the section is amended by
- 8 adding a subsection to read:
- 9 § 4303. Concealing death of child.
- 10 (a) Offense defined. -- A person is quilty of a [misdemeanor
- 11 of the first degree] <u>felony of the third degree</u> if he or she <u>as</u>
- 12 <u>a parent, individual residing in the same household as the child</u>
- 13 or an individual responsible for the child's welfare, endeavors
- 14 privately, either alone or by the procurement of others, to
- 15 conceal the death of [his or her] the child, so that it may not
- 16 come to light, whether it was born dead or alive or whether it

- 1 was murdered or not.

- 3 (c) Definition.--As used in this section, "parent" means a
- 4 <u>natural parent, stepparent, adoptive parent, quardian or an</u>
- 5 <u>individual involved in an intimate relationship with the child's</u>
- 6 parent.
- 7 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
