## AN ACT

- Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), entitled, 1 as amended, "An act providing for and reorganizing the 2 conduct of the executive and administrative work of the 3 Commonwealth by the Executive Department thereof and the administrative departments, boards, commissions, and officers thereof, including the boards of trustees of State Normal Schools, or Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, 7 reorganizing or authorizing the reorganization of certain 8 administrative departments, boards, and commissions; defining 9 the powers and duties of the Governor and other executive and 10 administrative officers, and of the several administrative 11 departments, boards, commissions, and officers; fixing the 12 salaries of the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain 13 other executive and administrative officers; providing for 14 the appointment of certain administrative officers, and of 15 all deputies and other assistants and employes in certain 16 departments, boards, and commissions; providing for judicial 17 administration; and prescribing the manner in which the 18 19 number and compensation of the deputies and all other assistants and employes of certain departments, boards and 20 commissions shall be determined," in Commonwealth budget 21 22 procedures, further providing for electronic access of 23 information. 24 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 25 hereby enacts as follows: 26 Section 1. Section 620.1 of the act of April 9, 1929 27 (P.L.177, No.175), known as The Administrative Code of 1929, is

- 1 Section 620.1. Electronic Access of Information.--[Except
- 2 for confidential information, the] (a) The Majority and
- 3 Minority Chairmen of the Appropriations Committees of the Senate
- 4 and House of Representatives shall have access to all
- 5 information available on inquiry-only screens through the
- 6 Integrated Central System.
- 7 (b) The Independent Fiscal Office shall be provided with the
- 8 same access to the Integrated Central System as the Office of
- 9 <u>the Budget.</u>
- 10 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
