6	Section 1. Section 5511.2(b) of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania
7	Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
8	§ 5511.2. Police animals.

10	(b) Illegal to torture police animalsIt shall be unlawful
11	for any person to willfully or maliciously torture, mutilate,
12	injure, disable, poison or kill a police animal. Any person who
13	violates any of the provisions of this subsection commits a
14	felony of the [third] <u>second</u> degree.

16	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
