## AN ACT

Amending the act of December 7, 1982 (P.L.784, No.225), entitled 1 2 "An act relating to dogs, regulating the keeping of dogs; providing for the licensing of dogs and kennels; providing 3 4 for the protection of dogs and the detention and destruction 5 of dogs in certain cases; regulating the sale and 6 transportation of dogs; declaring dogs to be personal 7 property and the subject of theft; providing for the 8 abandonment of animals; providing for the assessment of 9 damages done to animals; providing for payment of damages by the Commonwealth in certain cases and the liability of the 10 11 owner or keeper of dogs for such damages; imposing powers and 12 duties on certain State and local officers and employees; providing penalties; and creating a Dog Law Restricted 13 14 Account," in licenses, tags and kennels, further providing 15 for requirements for kennels; and abrogating a regulation. 16 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 17 hereby enacts as follows: 18 Section 1. Section 207(g), (h) heading, introductory paragraph and (7) and (i) heading and introductory paragraph of 19 20 the act of December 7, 1982 (P.L.784, No.225), known as the Dog 21 Law, are amended to read: 22 Section 207. Requirements for kennels.

- 1 [(g) Additional requirements for boarding kennels, nonprofit
- 2 kennels and Kennel Class I through VI license holders. -- The
- 3 following shall apply to boarding kennels, nonprofit kennels and
- 4 Kennel Class I through VI license holders:
- 5 (1) Kennels under this subsection must develop and
- follow an appropriate plan to provide dogs with the
- opportunity for exercise. The plan shall be approved by a
- 8 veterinarian.
- 9 (2) All kennels for dogs shall be equipped with smoke
- alarms or fire extinguishers. Housing facilities shall be
- 11 equipped with fire extinguishers on the premises. An indoor
- housing facility may have a sprinkler system.]
- 13 (h) Additional requirements for [Kennel Class C license
- 14 holders only] <u>primary enclosures in kennels</u>.--The following
- 15 shall apply only to primary enclosures for all dogs in [Kennel
- 16 Class C] kennels:

- 18 (7) Housing facilities for dogs must be sufficiently
- ventilated at all times when dogs are present to provide for
- their health and well-being and to minimize odors, drafts,
- 21 ammonia levels and to prevent moisture condensation. The
- 22 Canine Health Board shall determine auxiliary ventilation to
- 23 be provided if the ambient air temperature is 85 degrees F or
- higher. The relative humidity must be maintained at a level
- 25 that [ensures the health and well-being of the dogs housed
- therein] accomplishes a Heat Index value of 85 or lower. The
- appropriate ventilation[, humidity] and ammonia ranges shall
- 28 be determined by the Canine Health Board.

- 30 (i) Additional requirements for [Kennel Class C license

- 1 holders only] <u>kennels</u>.--The following shall apply only to dogs
- 2 over 12 weeks of age in [Kennel Class C] kennels:

- 4 Section 2. The provisions of 7 Pa. Code § 28a.4(a)(1) are
- 5 abrogated.
- 6 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
