AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, in fees, further providing for information
3 concerning drivers and vehicles.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Section 1955(a) of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:

8 § 1955. Information concerning drivers and vehicles.

9 (a) Drivers, registrations, titles and security interests.--

10 (1) The fee for a copy of written or electronic
11 information relating to a driver, registration, title or
12 security interest shall be \$8.

13 [(2) If a Commonwealth agency has entered into a
14 contract with a third party to deliver driver information to
15 a person that has complied with section 6114(b)(5) (relating
16 to limitation on sale, publication and disclosure of
17 records), the department may impose an additional fee of up

1 to \$2 for the requested record.

2 (3) Upon approval from the department, a person that has
3 received the driver information from the third party under
4 paragraph (2) that has complied with section 6114(b)(5) may
5 provide the information, for a fee, to a third party for the
6 same purposes contained in section 6114(b)(5) without the
7 payment of any additional fees under this subsection to the
8 department.]

9 (4) [Except as provided in paragraph (3), a] A person
10 that sells, publishes or discloses or offers to sell, publish
11 or disclose the information received by the person under this
12 subsection commits a summary offense and shall, upon
13 conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than \$500
14 nor more than \$1,000.

15 (5) The department shall comply with the provisions of
16 section 6114(d) with respect to the information of a driver
17 under 18 years of age whose information is provided to any
18 person under this subsection.

20 Section 2. This act shall take effect April 1, 2015, or
21 immediately, whichever is later.
