AN ACT

1 Amending Title 65 (Public Officers) of the Pennsylvania  
2 Consolidated Statutes, in ethics standards and financial  
3 disclosure, further providing for restricted activities.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Section 1103 of Title 65 of the Pennsylvania  
7 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read:  
8 § 1103. Restricted activities.

10 (k) Legislative fundraising on session days.--On a day when  
11 either house of the General Assembly is in session:

12 (1) No person shall offer or give to a public official  
13 or public employee of the legislative branch of this  
14 Commonwealth or a member of his immediate family or a  
15 business with which he is associated anything of monetary  
16 value, including a gift, loan or political contribution for a  
17 campaign for office in the legislative branch.

18 (2) No public official or public employee of the  
19 legislative branch of this Commonwealth shall solicit or

1 accept anything of monetary value, including a gift, loan or  
2 political contribution for a campaign for office in the  
3 legislative branch.

4 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
