AN ACT

- 1 Providing for the disclosure of communicable diseases in certain 2 facilities during disaster emergencies.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Short title.
- 6 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Communicable
- 7 Disease Reporting Act.
- 8 Section 2. Definitions.
- 9 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 10 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 11 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 12 "Facility." Any of the following:
- 13 (1) An assisted living residence as defined in section
- 14 1001 of the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), known as
- 15 the Human Services Code.
- 16 (2) A personal care home as defined in section 1001 of
- 17 the Human Services Code.

- 1 (3) A hospice as defined in section 802.1 of the act of
- 2 July 19, 1979 (P.L.130, No.48), known as the Health Care
- 3 Facilities Act, if the hospice renders care in an inpatient
- 4 setting.
- 5 (4) A long-term care nursing facility as defined in
- 6 section 802.1 of the Health Care Facilities Act.
- 7 (5) An intermediate care facility for persons with an
- 8 intellectual disability, as the term "intermediate care
- 9 facility for mentally retarded" is defined in section 1905(d)
- of the Social Security Act (49 Stat. 620, 42 U.S.C. §
- 11 1396d(d)).
- "Health care agent." As defined in 20 Pa.C.S. § 5422
- 13 (relating to definitions).
- "Health care representative." As defined in 20 Pa.C.S. §
- 15 5422.
- "Immediate family member." A spouse, child, stepchild,
- 17 parent, stepparent, grandparent, grandchild, brother,
- 18 stepbrother, sister, stepsister or like relative-in-law.
- "Secretary." The Secretary of Health of the Commonwealth.
- 20 Section 3. Information disclosure required.
- 21 (a) Release of information upon request. -- During a state of
- 22 disaster emergency under 35 Pa.C.S. § 7301(c) (relating to
- 23 general authority of Governor) that is due to a communicable
- 24 disease, a facility shall release the aggregate total number of
- 25 known cases of the communicable disease in the facility to a
- 26 health care agent, health care representative or immediate
- 27 family member of a resident of the facility, when the
- 28 information is requested by the health care agent, health care
- 29 representative or immediate family member of the resident of the
- 30 facility.

- 1 (b) Confidentiality. -- The information disclosed under
- 2 subsection (a) shall be presented in a manner that preserves
- 3 patient confidentiality.
- 4 Section 4. Enforcement.
- 5 Upon satisfactory evidence of a willful violation of this act
- 6 by a facility, the secretary may impose a civil penalty on the
- 7 facility of not less than \$250 nor more than \$1,000 for each
- 8 action in willful violation of this act.
- 9 Section 5. Effective date.
- 10 This act shall take effect immediately.
