AN ACT

Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain 2 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial 3 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the 4 laws relating thereto," in certification of teachers, further 5 providing for program of continuing professional education. 6 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 8 hereby enacts as follows: 9 Section 1. Section 1205.2(a) of the act of March 10, 1949 10 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, amended July 5, 2012 (P.L.965, No.105), is amended and the 11 section is amended by adding a subsection to read: 12 13 Section 1205.2. Program of Continuing Professional Education. -- (a) A continuing professional education program is 14 hereby established for professional educators, the satisfactory 15 16 completion of which is required to maintain active 17 certification. Except as provided in [subsection (n.1)] 18 subsections (n.1) and (n.2), the continuing professional 19 education program shall require the satisfactory completion of continuing professional education every five (5) years, which 20

- 1 shall include:
- 2 (1) six (6) credits of collegiate study;
- 3 (2) six (6) credits of continuing professional education
- 4 courses;
- 5 (3) one hundred eighty (180) hours of continuing
- 6 professional education programs, activities or learning
- 7 experiences; or
- 8 (4) any combination of collegiate studies, continuing
- 9 professional education courses, or other programs, activities or
- 10 learning experiences equivalent to one hundred eighty (180)
- 11 hours.

- 13 <u>(n.2) If, during a professional educator's five-year</u>
- 14 <u>compliance period under this section</u>, a <u>professional educator</u>
- 15 <u>satisfactorily completes continuing professional education</u>
- 16 <u>credits or hours in excess of the number of credits or hours</u>
- 17 required under subsection (a), any excess continuing
- 18 professional education credits or hours satisfying the
- 19 requirements of this section that are completed during the final
- 20 two years of a professional educator's five-year compliance
- 21 period up to a maximum of fifty (50) hours of continuing
- 22 professional education programs, activities or learning
- 23 experiences, or any combination of collegiate studies,
- 24 continuing professional education courses or other programs,
- 25 <u>activities or learning experiences equivalent to a maximum of</u>
- 26 fifty (50) hours, shall be credited to the professional
- 27 <u>educator's continuing professional education record for the next</u>
- 28 succeeding compliance period.
