AN ACT

- 1 Prohibiting certain gifts to members of the General Assembly.
- 2 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 3 hereby enacts as follows:
- 4 Section 1. Prohibition of certain gifts and favors.
- 5 Except as provided in section 2, no member of the General
- 6 Assembly may solicit or accept for the personal use of the
- 7 member or another individual a gift, gratuity, favor,
- 8 entertainment, hospitality, loan or other thing of monetary
- 9 value, including in-kind gifts, from a person who:
- 10 (1) Seeks to obtain business from or has financial
- 11 relations with the General Assembly or the Commonwealth.
- 12 (2) Conducts operations or activities that are regulated
- by the General Assembly or the Commonwealth.
- 14 (3) Engages, either as principal or attorney, in
- 15 proceedings before the Commonwealth or in court proceedings
- in which a member, the General Assembly or the Commonwealth

- 1 is an adverse party.
- 2 (4) Has interests that may be substantially affected by
- 3 the performance or nonperformance of the official duty of the
- 4 member.
- 5 Section 2. Applicability.
- 6 The provisions of section 1 shall not apply to:
- 7 (1) The solicitation or acceptance of something of
- 8 monetary value from a friend, parent, spouse, child or other
- 9 close relative of a member of the General Assembly under
- 10 circumstances which make it clear that the gift is motivated
- by a family relationship or personal friendship rather than
- 12 the position or official duties of the member. Relevant
- factors in making this determination include the history of
- 14 the relationship, including whether the friendship predates
- the member's first term elected to the General Assembly and
- whether the family member or friend pays for the gift.
- 17 (2) The acceptance of loans from banks or other
- 18 financial institutions on customary terms of finance for
- 19 proper and usual activities, including home-mortgage loans.
- 20 (3) Participation in widely attended gatherings free of
- 21 charge when members have been invited and are acting in
- furtherance of the member's official duties. This paragraph
- shall not apply to the acceptance of food or drink without a
- 24 member's payment at market value.
- 25 Section 3. Effective date.
- 26 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
