## AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An
- act relating to the public school system, including certain
- provisions applicable as well to private and parochial
- schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the
- laws relating thereto," providing for academic standards and
- 6 testing commission.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
- 10 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a
- 11 section to read:
- 12 Section 123. Academic Standards and Testing Commission. -- (a)
- 13 The State Board shall establish an Academic Standards and
- 14 Testing Commission to study and offer recommendations to the
- 15 State Board concerning the Commonwealth's academic standards and
- 16 assessments as provided for in this section.
- (b) (1) Not earlier than January 1, 2017, but not later
- 18 than February 1, 2017, the State Board shall appoint the members
- 19 of the commission, which shall include representatives of the
- 20 State Board, the department, business, school districts, charter

- 1 schools, cyber charter schools, regional charter schools, area
- 2 <u>vocational-technical schools, intermediate units, the State</u>
- 3 System of Higher Education, State-related universities,
- 4 <u>community colleges</u>, <u>independent colleges and universities and</u>
- 5 the United States Armed Forces.
- 6 (2) The commission shall appoint a member to serve as chair
- 7 of the commission.
- 8 (3) After appointing the commission pursuant to paragraph
- 9 (1), the State Board shall convene the first meeting of the
- 10 commission by March 1, 2017. The commission shall hold future
- 11 meetings at the call of the chair.
- 12 (4) Members of the commission shall not receive compensation
- 13 for their services, but shall be reimbursed for all necessary
- 14 travel and other reasonable expenses incurred in connection with
- 15 the performance of their duties as members of the commission.
- 16 (5) The department shall provide administrative support,
- 17 meeting space and any other assistance required by the
- 18 commission to carry out its duties under this section. The
- 19 <u>department shall also provide the commission and the State Board</u>
- 20 with data, research and other information upon request by the
- 21 commission or the State Board.
- 22 (c) The commission shall have the following powers and
- 23 duties:
- 24 (1) Review and make findings and recommendations related to
- 25 <u>the Commonwealth's academic standards and assessments.</u>
- 26 (2) Consult with and utilize experts to assist the
- 27 <u>commission in carrying out its duties under this section.</u>
- 28 (3) Hold public hearings.
- 29 <u>(4) Receive input from interested parties.</u>
- 30 (5) Review and consider academic standards and assessments

- 1 utilized throughout the United States.
- 2 (6) Within two (2) years after the commission's first
- 3 meeting, issue a report of its findings and recommendations to
- 4 the Governor, the President pro tempore of the Senate, the
- 5 Majority Leader and Minority Leader of the Senate, the Education
- 6 Committee of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of
- 7 Representatives, the Majority Leader and Minority Leader of the
- 8 House of Representatives, the Education Committee of the House
- 9 of Representatives, the Secretary of Education and the State
- 10 Board.
- 11 (d) Upon receipt of the report required under subsection (c)
- 12 <u>(6), the State Board shall consider the report and promulgate</u>
- 13 <u>regulations necessary to implement the recommendations pursuant</u>
- 14 to the act of June 25, 1982 (P.L.633, No.181), known as the
- 15 <u>"Regulatory Review Act."</u>
- (e) Every five (5) years following issuance of the
- 17 commission's report under subsection (c)(6), the commission
- 18 shall be reconstituted in accordance with subsection (b), shall
- 19 meet and hold public hearings to review the operation of the
- 20 Commonwealth's academic standards and assessments, shall make a
- 21 further report and shall issue the report to the recipients
- 22 listed in subsection (c)(6). When in receipt of a further report
- 23 <u>recommending changes to the Commonwealth's academic standards</u>
- 24 and assessments, the State Board shall consider the report and
- 25 promulgate regulations necessary to implement the
- 26 recommendations pursuant to the "Regulatory Review Act."
- 27 (f) As used in this section, the following words and phrases
- 28 shall have the meanings given to them in this subsection unless
- 29 the context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 30 "Academic standards." The academic standards established

- 1 pursuant to 22 Pa. Code Chapter 4 (relating to academic
- 2 standards and assessment).
- 3 "Assessment." The Pennsylvania System of School Assessment
- 4 test, the Keystone Exam or another test established by the State
- 5 Board pursuant to 22 Pa. Code § 4.51(f) (relating to State
- 6 <u>assessment system</u>).
- 7 "Commission." The Academic Standards and Testing Commission
- 8 established under this section.
- 9 "Department." The Department of Education of the
- 10 Commonwealth.
- "State Board." The State Board of Education.
- 12 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
