AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated  
2 Statutes, in fees, further providing for information  
3 concerning drivers and vehicles.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Section 1955(a) of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania  
7 Consolidated Statutes, amended November 25, 2013 (P.L. ,  
8 No.89), is amended to read:

9 § 1955. Information concerning drivers and vehicles.

10 (a) Drivers, registrations, titles and security interests.--

11 [(1)] The fee for a copy of written or electronic  
12 information relating to a driver, registration, title or  
13 security interest shall be [\$5.] \$8.

14 [(2) If a Commonwealth agency has entered into a  
15 contract with a third party to deliver driver information to  
16 a person that has complied with section 6114(b)(5) (relating  
17 to limitation on sale, publication and disclosure of

1 records), the department may impose an additional fee of up  
2 to \$2 for the requested record.

3 (3) Upon approval from the department, a person that has  
4 received the driver information from the third party under  
5 paragraph (2) that has complied with section 6114(b)(5) may  
6 provide the information, for a fee, to a third party for the  
7 same purposes contained in section 6114(b)(5) without the  
8 payment of any additional fees under this subsection to the  
9 department.

10 (4) Except as provided in paragraph (3), a person that  
11 sells, publishes or discloses or offers to sell, publish or  
12 disclose the information received by the person under this  
13 subsection commits a summary offense and shall, upon  
14 conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than \$500  
15 nor more than \$1,000.

16 (5) The department shall comply with the provisions of  
17 section 6114(d) with respect to the information of a driver  
18 under 18 years of age whose information is provided to any  
19 person under this subsection.]

21 Section 2. This act shall take effect April 1, 2014, or  
22 immediately, whichever is later.
