- 1 Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the
- Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in forfeiture of assets,
- further providing for asset forfeiture.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 5803(i) of Title 42 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes, added June 29, 2017 (P.L.247, No.13), is
- 8 amended to read:
- 9 § 5803. Asset forfeiture.
- 10 * * *
- 11 (i) Authorization to utilize property. -- Cash or proceeds of
- 12 property subject to forfeiture under section 5802 and
- 13 transferred to the custody of the district attorney or Attorney
- 14 General under subsection (f) shall be utilized by the district
- 15 attorney or Attorney General for the enforcement of or
- 16 prevention of a violation of the provisions of The Controlled
- 17 Substance, Drug, Device and Cosmetic Act. In appropriate cases,
- 18 the district attorney and the Attorney General may designate

- 1 proceeds from the forfeited property to be utilized by
- 2 community-based drug and crime-fighting programs, for school
- 3 <u>safety and security efforts</u> and for relocation and protection of
- 4 witnesses in criminal cases. Real property may be transferred to
- 5 a nonprofit organization to alleviate blight resulting from
- 6 violations of The Controlled Substance, Drug, Device and
- 7 Cosmetic Act.

- 9 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
