AN ACT

Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An 1 act relating to the public school system, including certain 2 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial 3 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," in collective bargaining, further 5 providing for definitions and providing for union leave. 6 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 8 hereby enacts as follows: 9 Section 1. Section 1101-A of the act of March 10, 1949 10 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding definitions to read: 11 12 Section 1101-A. Definitions. -- When used in this article, the 13 following words and phrases shall have the following meanings: 14 15 "Statewide employe organization" shall mean the Statewide affiliated parent organization of an employe organization. 17 * * * "Substitute" shall have the meaning given to it in section 18 1101. 19

- 1 "Union leave" shall mean any arrangement under which an
- 2 employe takes leave from employment with an employer for the
- 3 purpose of service with a Statewide employe organization or an
- 4 <u>employe organization</u>.
- 5 Section 2. The act is amended by adding a section to read:
- 6 <u>Section 1173-A. Union Leave.--(a) Subject to subsection</u>
- 7 (b), notwithstanding 24 Pa.C.S. § 8302 (relating to credited
- 8 school service) or any other provision of law, no collective
- 9 <u>bargaining agreement or contract between an employe organization</u>
- 10 and school district entered into, renewed or extended on or
- 11 after the effective date of this section may allow an employe to
- 12 <u>take union leave from an employer.</u>
- (b) Notwithstanding subsection (a), the following shall
- 14 apply:
- 15 (1) Each Statewide employe organization may designate not
- 16 more than three (3) individuals throughout the Commonwealth at
- 17 any time who may take union leave, provided that each designated
- 18 individual may take union leave for a cumulative period of no
- 19 more than six (6) school years, subject to subsection (c).
- 20 (2) An employe who is not designated under paragraph (1) may
- 21 take union leave for no more than three (3) consecutive days
- 22 within any week and for a cumulative period of no more than
- 23 fifteen (15) days each school year, subject to subsection (c).
- (c) When an employe is permitted to take union leave from an
- 25 <u>employer pursuant to subsection (b) or pursuant to a collective</u>
- 26 bargaining agreement or contract entered into prior to the
- 27 <u>effective date of this section and remaining in effect on the</u>
- 28 effective date of this section, the following shall apply,
- 29 except as prohibited by a collective bargaining agreement or
- 30 contract entered into prior to the effective date of this

- 1 section and remaining in effect on the effective date of this
- 2 section:
- 3 (1) The Statewide employe organization or employe
- 4 <u>organization shall reimburse the employer for:</u>
- 5 (i) Any monetary compensation or benefits accrued by an
- 6 employe during the period of union leave.
- 7 (ii) The services of any substitute engaged by the employer
- 8 to perform the duties of the employe during the period of union
- 9 leave.
- 10 (iii) Any contribution made by the employer on behalf of the
- 11 employe under 24 Pa.C.S. § 8327 (relating to payments by
- 12 <u>employers</u>) for the period of union leave with valuation
- 13 <u>interest.</u>
- 14 (iv) Any contribution made by the employer on behalf of the
- 15 employe under the Social Security Act (49 Stat. 620, 42 U.S.C. §
- 16 <u>301 et seq.) for the period of union leave.</u>
- 17 (2) No payments shall be made to the employer from funds
- 18 appropriated for payment of required contributions for public
- 19 school employes' retirement on behalf of the employe with
- 20 respect to the period of union leave, notwithstanding 24 Pa.C.S.
- 21 §§ 8326 (relating to contributions by the Commonwealth) and 8535
- 22 (relating to payments to school entities by Commonwealth).
- 23 (3) No payments shall be made to the employer from funds
- 24 appropriated for school employes' Social Security with respect
- 25 to the employe for the period of union leave, notwithstanding 24
- 26 Pa.C.S. § 8329 (relating to payments on account of social
- 27 <u>security deductions from appropriations</u>).
- 28 (d) No collective bargaining agreement or contract between
- 29 <u>an employe organization and a school district entered into,</u>
- 30 renewed or extended on or after the effective date of this

- 1 section shall contain provisions contrary to subsection (a), (b)
- 2 <u>or (c).</u>
- 3 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
