AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An
- act relating to the public school system, including certain
- provisions applicable as well to private and parochial
- schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the
- laws relating thereto," in books, furniture and supplies,
- 6 providing for school library collections.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
- 10 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a
- 11 section to read:
- 12 <u>Section 811. School Library Collections.--(a) Beginning</u>
- 13 with the 2025-2026 school year, each public school shall
- 14 maintain a library collection that includes a variety of both
- 15 print and nonprint materials and related equipment of sufficient
- 16 quality and quantity to support and supplement the educational
- 17 needs of students, including a minimum quantity of one thousand
- 18 (1,000) items per grade served. A public school may satisfy the
- 19 requirements under this subsection by providing access to

- 1 <u>library resources from a local library, county library or</u>
- 2 <u>library system as defined in 24 Pa.C.S. § 9302 (relating to</u>
- 3 definitions).
- 4 (b) A certified school librarian may direct the development
- 5 and implementation of a library of a public school.
- 6 (c) The department shall promulgate regulations as necessary
- 7 to implement this section.
- 8 (d) As used in this section, the following words and phrases
- 9 shall have the meanings given to them in this subsection:
- 10 "Department." The Department of Education of the
- 11 <u>Commonwealth.</u>
- "Items." Books, films, filmstrips, tapes, records, globes,
- 13 slide sets, periodicals, audio-visual equipment, maps and other
- 14 <u>items to supplement a public school's programs. The term does</u>
- 15 not include books classified as textbooks, except when used in
- 16 <u>limited numbers as reference books.</u>
- 17 <u>"Public school." A school operated by a school district,</u>
- 18 intermediate unit or charter school.
- 19 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
