9	(P.L.397, No.141), known as the Educator Discipline Act, is

11	Section 17.1. Immunity From Liability* * *
12	(a.1) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, no person
13	shall be subject to discipline or civil liability for refusing,
14	in the absence of malice, to use an individual's preferred
15	pronouns.

17	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
