## AN ACT

- Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain 2 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial 3 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the 4 laws relating thereto," in school health services, providing 5 for parent educational information regarding eating 6 disorders. 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 10 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a section to read:

- Section 1426. Parent Educational Information Regarding 1.3
- Eating Disorders. -- (a) Each school entity shall annually 14
- 15 provide parent educational information regarding eating
- disorders for pupils in grades six through twelve. The 16
- 17 information shall be consistent with guidelines established
- 18 under this section.
- (b) Each school entity shall provide the annual parent 19
- 20 educational information to all parents and quardians via email,
- first class mail or on the school entity's publicly accessible 21

- 2 <u>(c) The following shall apply:</u>
- 3 (1) The Department of Education, in conjunction with the
- 4 Department of Health, shall develop an Eating Disorders Task
- 5 Force that shall develop and implement guidelines for providing
- 6 parent educational information regarding eating disorders. The
- 7 <u>quidelines shall be developed with input from specialized</u>
- 8 organizations and entities, including boards of school
- 9 directors, school superintendents, the National Alliance for
- 10 Eating Disorders, the Pennsylvania Association of School Nurses
- 11 and Practitioners, the Pennsylvania Chapter of the American
- 12 Academy of Pediatrics, the Pennsylvania Academy of Family
- 13 Physicians, the International Association of Eating Disorders
- 14 Professionals Foundation and the Academy for Eating Disorders.
- 15 (2) The Eating Disorders Task Force shall meet at least two
- 16 times per school year to reassess the information provided to
- 17 schools and to parents. The task force shall meet at least once
- 18 prior to the school year beginning and shall meet at least once
- 19 in the beginning of the calendar year.
- 20 (d) The Department of Education, the Department of Health
- 21 and the Eating Disorders Task Force shall identify and develop
- 22 appropriate additions or revisions to this Commonwealth's school
- 23 health regulations and materials related to the development of
- 24 parent educational information, including guidance regarding the
- 25 clear delineation of health information from other
- 26 administrative documentation.
- 27 <u>(e) The guidelines developed under this section shall</u>
- 28 include the following:
- 29 (1) The development of a letter for key school personnel,
- 30 including school principals, vice principals and school

- 1 counselors and psychologists, on the importance of eating
- 2 <u>disorder prevention education and resources for schools.</u>
- 3 (2) The development of a letter to parents and quardians
- 4 that includes warning signs, risk factors, resources and other
- 5 <u>information about eating disorders.</u>
- 6 (f) As used in this section, the term "school entity" means
- 7 <u>an area career and technical school, a charter school, a cyber</u>
- 8 <u>charter school, an intermediate unit, a nonpublic school or a</u>
- 9 <u>school district.</u>
- 10 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
