Section 1109(a) of Title 65 is amended to read: § 1109. Penalties. 20 21 (a) Restricted activities violation .-- Any person who

violates the provisions of section 1103(a), (b) [and (c)], (c) and (c.1) (relating to restricted activities) commits a felony and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than \$10,000 or to imprisonment for not more than five years, or both.
