## AN ACT

Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania 1 Consolidated Statutes, in human trafficking, further 2 providing for evidence and defenses to human trafficking. 3 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 5 hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. Section 3018(a) of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended and the section is amended by adding a subsection to read: 8 9 § 3018. Evidence and defenses to human trafficking. 10 (a) General rule. -- Evidence of the [following facts or conditions] age of the victim of human trafficking with respect 11 to the age of consent to sex or legal age of marriage shall not 12 constitute a defense in a prosecution for a violation under this 13 14 chapter, nor shall the evidence preclude a finding of a 15 violation under this chapter.[: Specific instances of past sexual conduct of the 16 victim of human trafficking, opinion evidence of the alleged 17

victim's past sexual conduct and reputation evidence of the

- in a prosecution under this chapter, except evidence of the
- 3 alleged victim's past sexual conduct with the defendant shall

- 18 (a.1) Evidence of victim's sexual conduct.--The provisions
- 19 of section 3104 (relating to evidence of victim's sexual
- 20 conduct) shall apply to prosecutions under this chapter.
