AN ACT

- Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain
- provisions applicable as well to private and parochial
- schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the
- laws relating thereto," in school health services, providing 5
- for type 1 diabetes education parental notification. 6
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
- as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a 10
- 11 section to read:
- 12 Section 1414.12. Type 1 Diabetes Education Parental
- Notification. -- (a) The department, in coordination with other 13
- 14 entities deemed appropriate by the department, shall develop
- 15 type 1 diabetes informational materials for parents and
- 16 quardians. The informational materials may include all of the
- 17 following:

- 1 (1) A description of type 1 diabetes.
- 2 (2) A description of risk factors and warning signs
- 3 <u>associated with type 1 diabetes.</u>
- 4 (3) A recommendation that a parent or guardian of a student
- 5 <u>displaying warning signs associated with type 1 diabetes</u>
- 6 <u>immediately consult with the student's primary care provider to</u>
- 7 <u>determine if immediate screening for type 1 diabetes is</u>
- 8 appropriate.
- 9 (4) A description of the screening process for type 1
- 10 diabetes, the significance of its stages and the implications of
- 11 test results identifying the presence of stage 1, stage 2 and
- 12 <u>stage 3 type 1 diabetes.</u>
- 13 <u>(5) A recommendation that a parent or guardian of a student</u>
- 14 who has been diagnosed with type 1 diabetes should consult with
- 15 the student's primary care provider to develop an appropriate
- 16 treatment plan which may include consultation with and
- 17 examination by a specialty care provider, including a properly
- 18 <u>qualified endocrinologist.</u>
- 19 (b) The department shall periodically update the
- 20 <u>informational materials developed under subsection (a) as</u>
- 21 necessary and make the informational materials available on its
- 22 <u>publicly accessible Internet website.</u>
- 23 (c) Beginning January 1, 2025, each school entity shall make
- 24 the informational materials developed under subsection (a)
- 25 available in writing, ELECTRONICALLY OR ON THE SCHOOL ENTITY'S <--
- 26 PUBLICLY ACCESSIBLE INTERNET WEBSITE, to the parent or guardian
- 27 of a student when a student is first enrolled in elementary
- 28 school and again upon a student's entry into grade six.
- 29 (d) As used in this section, the following words and phrases
- 30 shall have the meanings given to them in this subsection unless

- 1 the context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 2 "Department" shall mean the Department of Education HEALTH of <--
- 3 <u>the Commonwealth.</u>
- 4 "School entity" shall mean a school district, area career and
- 5 technical school, charter school, regional charter school, cyber
- 6 <u>charter school or</u>, <u>intermediate unit OR NONPUBLIC SCHOOL</u>. <--
- 7 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
